### Phase 2, Part 1

Thanks to many generous donors, the Restore the Roar initiative has completed Part 1 of Phase 2 with the installation of a new fence. From barbed wire to beautiful, the new fence features sponsored brick pillars. The home side ticket booth was demolished and rebuilt, which adds to the overall aesthetic of the site.

## Grants Make a Difference

In the Spring of 2019, the HASD Foundation awarded nearly \$17,000 in grants to classrooms in the district. A collaborative seating grant for foreign language was awarded at the Junior High, something instructor Alicia Schmouder says has made the kids more relaxed and attuned in the classroom. According to Josh Dietrich, a grant to build a STEAM Adventureland allowed the Kindergarten teachers "to create learning stations where students can explore manipulatives such as magnatiles, coding robots, pulleys/levers, and Legos to foster a love of math and the sciences at a young age. Students visit the Adventureland on a weekly basis to engage in 21st century concepts such as engineering and robotics as well as the arts through dramatic play."
